## Re: Meeting with the Alliance for Sustainable Legal Aid

I am writing on behalf of the Alliance for Sustainable Legal Aid (ASLA) to offer our congratulations on your recent appointment as chair of the board of Legal Aid Ontario (LAO). Your background as the Attorney General who introduced the Legal Aid Services Act will serve LAO well, and more importantly, the vulnerable people who depend on LAO.

You come to this role at a difficult time. The provincial government budget's forecast of a $\$ 133$ million reduction in transfer payments is profound. It is anticipated this cut will be followed by a further reduction of $\$ 31$ million in the next fiscal year. I cannot overestimate the impact these changes will have on the administration of justice in Ontario. As key stakeholders in access to justice, and representing those delivering front line services to the poor, we would ask to meet with you urgently to discuss what might be done to ensure an appropriate level of sustainable legal aid services in the near and immediate future.

ASLA has worked for many years to ensure the sustainability and enhancement of legal aid services; all of us are now gravely challenged in achieving our mutual objectives.

We are anxious to meet with you as soon as possible to discuss how we can protect the province's most vulnerable people.
